THE COLLABORATIVE WORKSHOP AT RGNIIPM

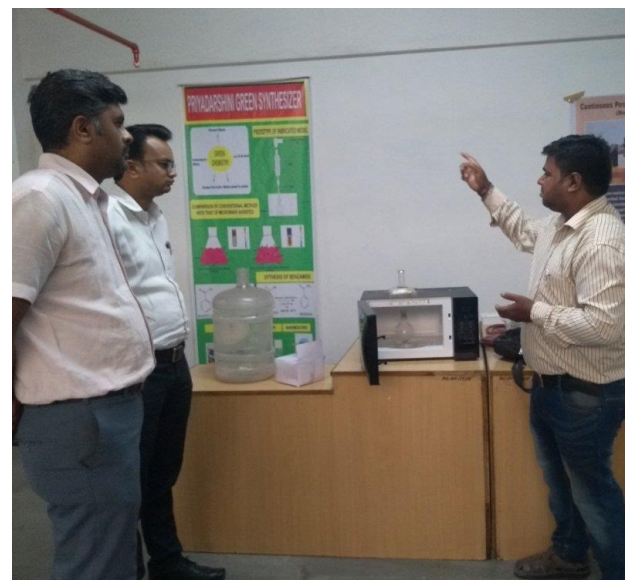

GEOGRAPHICAL INDICATIONS (GI)

- ▶ A sign/ name/ geographical or figurative representation or combination thereof used on goods that have a specific geographical origin and possess qualities or a reputation that are due to that origin.
- ▶ There is a clear link between the product and its original place of production.
- ▶ A communal intellectual property right.
- ▶ Goods – any agricultural, natural or manufactured goods or any goods of handicraft or of industry and includes foodstuff.
- ▶ Valid for 10 years and thereafter subject to renewal.

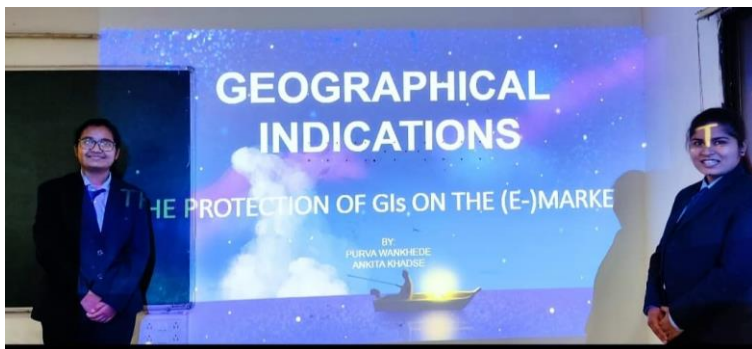

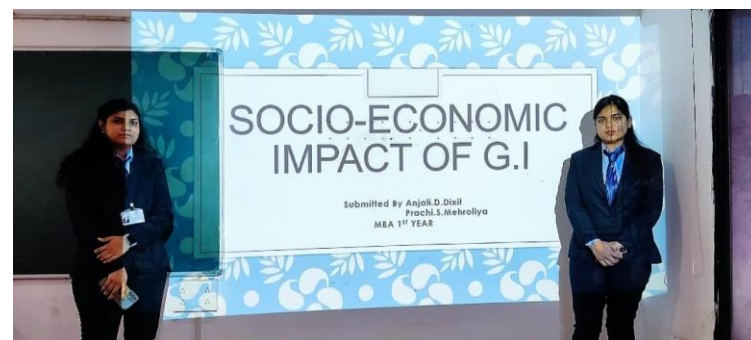

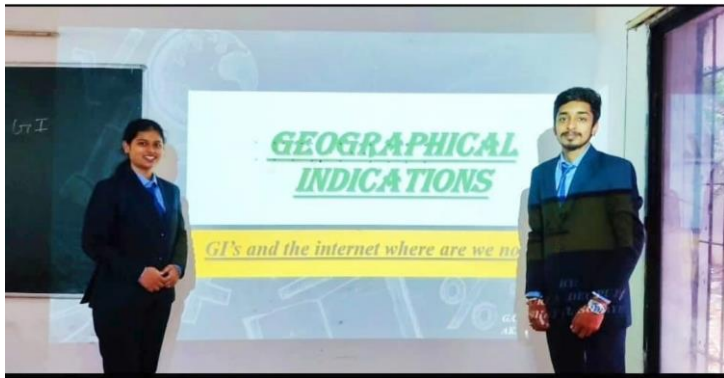
