

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") is made and executed on the 12th Day of January

Month 2024 at Baramati

BETWEEN:

AIC-ADT Baramati Foundation (Atal Incubation Centre-Agricultural Development
Trust Baramati Foundation) is a Business and Startup Incubator supported by Atal
Innovation Mission, Niti Aayog, Government of India. AIC-ADT Baramati Foundation
started its operation on 1st April 2019 as an agriculture and allied sector-focused business
incubator. It is one of its kind Agri and Allied tech-based incubator supporting facility to
shape the idea or innovation of young rural minds and transform these innovations into a
commercially viable product. Henceforth referred to as Knowledge Partner,





WHEREAS:

- a. AIC-ADT Baramati Foundation is an Incubation Centre supported by Atal Innovation Mission, NITI Aayog, and Government of India. The objective of the AIC-ADT is to reach rural innovative ideas and create high class incubation facilities with suitable physical infrastructure in terms of capital equipment and operating facilities, coupled with the availability of sectoral experts for mentoring the start-ups so that innovators and start-up businesses can become successful entrepreneurs and enterprises. The Centre aims to be a common platform for the students, faculties, institutes, individuals, entrepreneurs, start-ups to hone the necessary skills of entrepreneurship and accordingly shape the ideas to a marketable product.
- b. Career Katta is an initiative of the Department of Higher and Technical Education, Government of Maharashtra, in collaboration with the Maharashtra Information Technology Support Centre. Under this scheme, selected colleges will receive training in implementing best practices to effectively operate incubation facilities referred to as "Centres of Excellence" within their own premises.

All the Parties are willing to cooperate in order to facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the First Party by providing significant inputs to them in developing a suitable innovation ecosystem, by entering into this MoU, upon the terms and conditions as stated herein (hereinafter referred as the "Program").

IN CONSIDERATION OF THEIR RESPECTIVE OBLIGATIONS, COVENANTS, RIGHTS, AND WARRANTIES AND REPRESENTATIONS HEREIN CONTAINED, IT IS AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

1. Purpose:

The purpose of this MoU is to provide a framework of cooperation and to facilitate collaboration between the Parties, on a non-exclusive basis, in areas of mutual interest for the successful achievement of the Program.





12. Empower Trainers for CSR Donor Pitches:

Equip trainers with the knowledge and skills necessary for effectively pitching to small CSR donors.

2. Communication and exchange of information:

The Parties shall, on a regular basis, keep each other informed of and consult on matters of common interests, which in their opinion are likely to further the collaborative efforts of the parties as documented in this MoU.

3. Use of Logos

A Party shall obtain the express written consent of the other Party before using the Logo/Symbol/Trademark of each other.

4. Effective date, duration, and termination of the MoU:

The MoU shall be effective from the date of its execution and shall remain in force for a period of Five years. The parties may extend the term in writing. The MoU may be terminated by either Party by giving a written notice of 30 days to the other party, without assigning any reason thereof.

5. Confidentiality:

i. Confidential Information includes all communication of information/ideas disclosed/derived in documentary or tangible form between the Parties, including oral, written, and machine-readable forms. In the case of such information disclosed orally or visually, the Disclosing Party shall confirm in writing the fact and general nature of each disclosure within (30) days after it is made. The Party disclosing the Confidential Information shall be referred to as the Disclosing Party. The Party receiving the Confidential Information shall be referred to as the Receiving Party.

6. Represents and Warranties

Both the Parties hereby represent and warrant that:

- a) It is a duly organized entity, validly existing and fully compliant with all applicable law.
- b) It has all corporate, statutory, and other authorizations, licenses, and consents necessary to legally execute and perform its obligations under the MoU and shall continue to have all such





The Knowledge Partner agrees to provide knowledge and expertise for the "Train the Trainers" (ToT) program to enhance the capabilities of the Client's Institute/Centre of Excellence in establishing and sustaining an Incubation and Innovation ecosystem.

10.2 Consultancy Fees:

In consideration for the consultancy services rendered, the Client agrees to pay the Knowledge Partner a consultancy fee of Rs. 15000/- per trainee per year per center participating in the ToT program, with 10% increase in fees every year.

10.3 Payment Terms:

Payment of the consultancy fees shall be made through online/offline payment methods not later than one month from the commencement of the program.

11. Governing Law


This MoU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called as "MOU") is entered into on this 15 Day of May 2023.

BETWEEN

Dhanwate National College Nagpur represented by Dr. Bharti Khapekar_Principal (hereinafter referred as "First Party", the institute which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors-in-office, administrators and assigns).

AND

GGC'S PRACTICAL TRAINING ACADEMY PRIVATE LIMITED, 201, Cecil Court, Behind Taj Mahal Palace, Colaba, Mumbai, Maharashtra -400001 represented herein by Mr Sumit Tajpuriya (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors-in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party").

WHEREAS

A) First Party is a one of the most reputed colleges of Nagpur named – Dhanwate National College First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.

B) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research. The Department of Training and Placement has initiated the MOU process for the First Party.

C) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interest.

D) GGC'S PRACTICAL TRAINING ACADEMY PRIVATE LIMITED, the Second Party is engaged in Business of financial consultancy and training and skill development and GGC'S PRACTICAL TRAINING ACADEMY PRIVATE LIMITED the Second Party is promoted by Promoter name Mr Sumit Tajpuriya, GGC'S PRACTICAL TRAINING ACADEMY PRIVATE LIMITED

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:



CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all the information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable

teaching/training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the


Second Party.

1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall co-operate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the "Definitive Documents") as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.



CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MOU ALONG WITH TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the Institutions could play a key role by acting as skilled finance professionals of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student and youth community to enhance their skills and knowledge and employability.
- 2.2 Training Methodology: Second Party would provide virtual training to students of First Party and conduct live sessions once a week.
- 2.3 Hands on Training: The practical training and exposure provided to selected students through internship opportunities which will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career.



- 2.5 Skill Development Programs Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging cloud-based technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- 2.6 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions and licences of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein.



- 2.7 It is agreed between the parties that Second Party would provide virtual training on 8 modules as listed on the website of second party for 45 days.
- 2.8 Post completion of 45 days of training, an eligibility test would be conducted and candidates scoring more than 60% marks would be shortlisted and provided internship opportunities in CA firms.
- 2.9 A certificate would also be issued by Second Party to all the candidates of First Party based on the scores of the Eligibility Test (ET).
- 2.10 Second Party would charge Rs. 1000 per candidate which needs to be paid upfront.
- 2.11 Post completion of training of first batch of First Party, the professional charges as mentioned in above point may be revised after mutual discussions based on the results of training of first batch.



CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, /estoppels or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest or licence in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to knowhow, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.



CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid till 3 years from the date of signing until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period GGC'S PRACTICAL TRAINING ACADEMY PRIVATE LIMITED, the Second Party, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU.
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

CLAUSE 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

- 5.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under the MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorised to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party, Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.
- 5.2 Post signing of this MOU, second party would be able to display name of First Party and its candidates on its portal.

Terms and Conditions of MOU signed in May 2023 between Dhanwate National College Nagpur and GGC'S Practical Training Academy Private Limited

- 1.1 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licences of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein.
- 1.2 It is agreed between the parties that Second Party would provide virtual training on 8 modules as listed on the website of second party for 45 days.
- 1.3 Training would be provided virtually through app and weekly live sessions would also be conducted virtually in which Chartered Accountants would interact with the enrolled candiadtes to solve there doubts.
- 1.4 Post completion of 45 days of training, an eligibility test would be conducted and candidates scoring more than 60% marks would be shortlisted and provided internship opportunities in CA firms.
- 1.5 A certificate would also be issued by Second Party to all the candidates of First Party based on the scores of the Eligibility Test (ET). Since the certificate would be issued by RTMNU it would make the enrolled candidates eligible for 3 credit points.

- 1.8 Post signing of this MOU, second party would be able to display name of First Party and its candidates on its website.
- 1.9 Other terms and conditions as displayed on the website of Green Growth Consultancy Private Limited would also be applicable.
- 1.9 Entire fees for the Course will be Covered (Paid) through Sponsorship & College will not be responsible for any fee's payment
- 1.10 The RTMNU Certificate will be issued in coming Semester
