**Objective:**

### **3. Monitoring, Evaluation, and Feedback:**

- Both parties will jointly monitor progress, assess outcomes, and gather feedback from participants to continuously refine the program, aiming for measurable improvements in students' skills and job-readiness.


### **4. Community and Industry Engagement:**


