## **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

### **PURPOSE OF MOU**

This MOU aims to foster a robust collaboration between the Department of Physical Education & Sports of Dhanwate National College and the Nagpur District Chess Association for the holistic development of students in the realm of Chess.

#### **The primary objectives include :**

1. **Inculcate interest** : To instill a genius interest in chess among the students of Dhanwate National College, encouraging them to utilize their spare time productively through engaging class activities.
2. **Skill Development Workshop** : Conduct various workshops focused on chess skill development, offering students practical insights and strategies to enhance their proficiency in the Game.
3. **Practical Training** : Provided hands-on, practical training sessions aimed at honing the chess skill of the students, ensuring they are well-prepared for competitive scenarios.
4. **Competition Opportunities** : Create avenues for students to participate in various chess competitions, nurturing a competitive spirit and offering exposure to the competitive chess landscape.
5. **Entrepreneurship Support**: Support and guide students in establishing chess-related start-ups, fostering entrepreneurship within the Chess community.

6. **Tournaments Participation** : Facilitate the entry of trained students in to Chess tournaments, providing them with opportunities to showcase their skills on a broader stage.

**NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:**

**Clause 1**

**COOPERATION**

- 1.1 Both parties, driven by common interests and objectives, shall establish open channels of communication and cooperation to share potential opportunities and relevant information that may benefit each other's operations.
- 1.2 The collaboration will allow the Department of Physical Education & Sports to harness the intellectual capabilities of the Nagpur District Chess Association, receiving valuable inputs to develop tailored teaching and training systems aligned with the need of the College.

**Clause 2**

**SCOPE OF THE MOU**

- 2.3 Regular interaction will keep both parties abreast of the latest developments and needs in the field of chess; providing opportunities for faculty and students of Dhanwate National College to participate in the training programs organized by the Nagpur District Chess Association.
- 2.4 The Nagpur District Chess Association will actively train Dhanwate National College students on emerging technologies, addressing skill gaps and preparing them for competitive challenges.



Objective	Providing an opportunity for chess players to play a competition on the occasion of Bhausaheb's birth anniversary.
Brief Report	<p>In the college, the Sports Department organized the Vidarbha Level Two Player Team Open Rapid Chess Tournament on the occasion of the 126th birth anniversary of Shri Shivaji Shikshan Sanstha Amravati's founder Shikshan Maharshi Krishi Ratna Dr. Punjabrav Deshmukh on December 22, 2024 in association with NDCA. The inauguration of this competition was held in the college's Matoshree Vimalabai Deshmukh Hall under the auspices of Shri Shreyash Kamdar - Vice President DCA and under the chairmanship of Dr. Vaishali Malode - IQAC Coordinator. The chief guests on this occasion were the Secretary of the DCA Shri K K Barad, HoD Dr. Devendra Wankhade, Chief Orbiter Shri Praveen Pantavane, Junior College Supervisor Prof. Jayant Jichkar. The program was coordinated by Dr. Bhavana Khulsule and the vote of thanks was expressed by Dr. Subhash Dadhe.</p> <p>A total of 46 teams participated in this competition. The competition lasted from 10.00 am to 6.00 pm.
