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**ONLINE STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY (SSS)
ON
TEACHING, LEARNING AND EVALUATION
SESSION 2021-2022 (FOR UG AND PG STUDENTS)**

Based on the provided responses from 1746 participants in the Student Satisfaction Survey for session 2022-23 at Dhanwate National College, nagpur was conducted to gather feedback on teaching-learning practices, evaluation methods, and research opportunities in higher education. The aim was to identify areas for improvement to enhance the quality of education provided.

Methodology:

- ◆ The survey was distributed electronically to all students.
- ◆ A total of 1746 responses were received, representing a significant portion of the student body.
- ◆ The survey included questions related to teaching methods, course content, evaluation procedures, and research opportunities.

Key Findings:

1. Teaching Methods:

- ◆ 82% of students expressed satisfaction with the overall quality of teaching.
- ◆ 76% felt that instructors effectively communicated course material.
- ◆ 68% found the use of technology in teaching to be beneficial.

2. Course Content:

- ◆ 74% believed that the curriculum was relevant and up-to-date.
- ◆ 69% expressed satisfaction with the variety of courses offered.

3. Evaluation Procedures:

- ◆ 78% felt that evaluation criteria were clearly defined.
- ◆ 72% were satisfied with the feedback provided on their performance.

4. Research Opportunities:

- ◆ 60% were aware of research opportunities available to them.
- ◆ 54% expressed interest in participating in research projects.

Recommendations:



Based on the survey findings, the following recommendations are proposed to improve the quality of education:

- ◆ Enhance faculty training programs to improve teaching methods and use of technology.
- ◆ Regularly update the curriculum to ensure its relevance to current industry standards.
- ◆ Provide more opportunities for students to engage in research projects and academic conferences.

Conclusion:

The Student Satisfaction Survey provides valuable insights into areas where improvements can be made to enhance the quality of education in higher education institutions. By implementing the recommendations outlined in this report, institutions can ensure a more enriching and fulfilling learning experience for students.

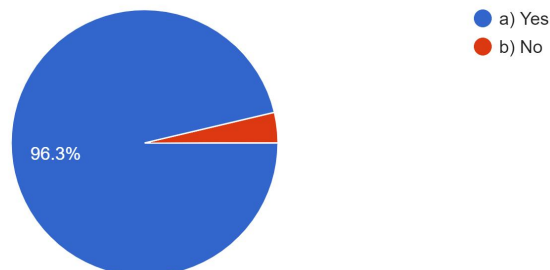

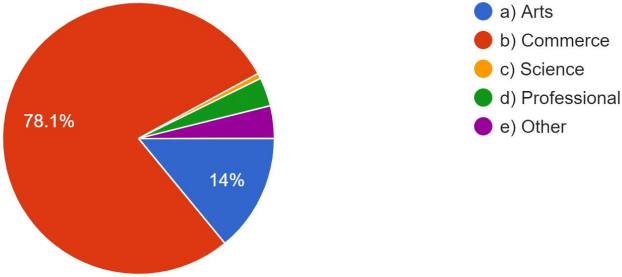

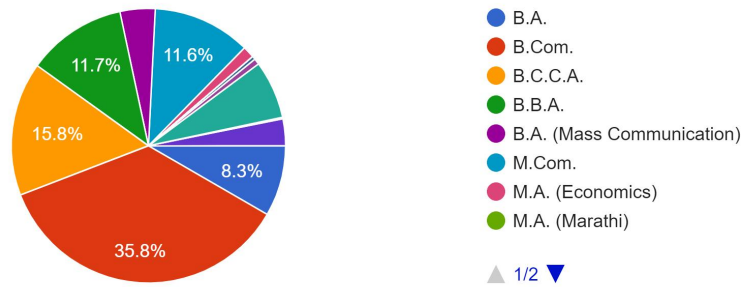


F) What subject area are you currently pursuing?)

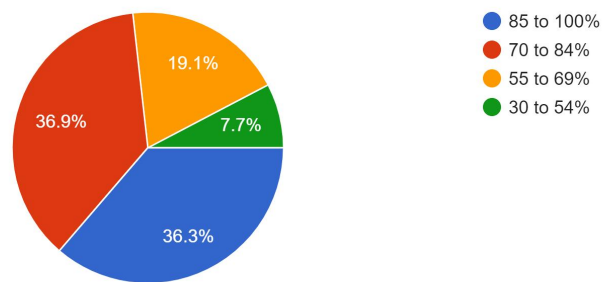

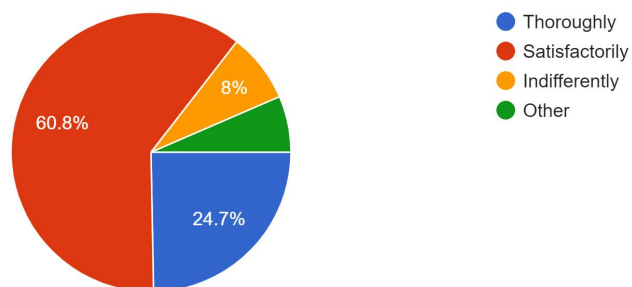
1) How much percentage of the syllabus was covered in the session?

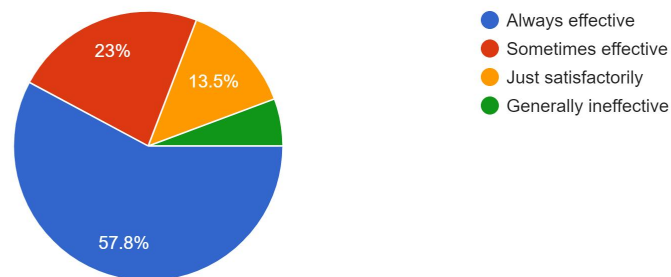
2) How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

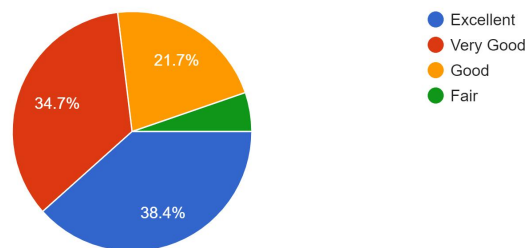
3) How well were the teachers able to communicate with class?

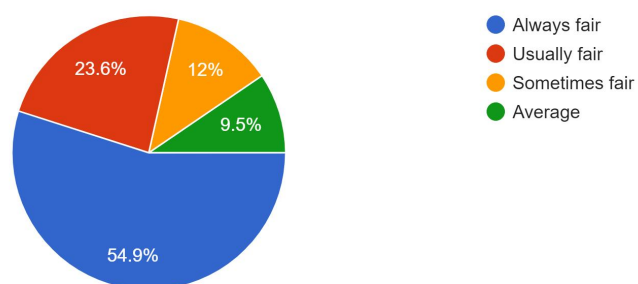
4) The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

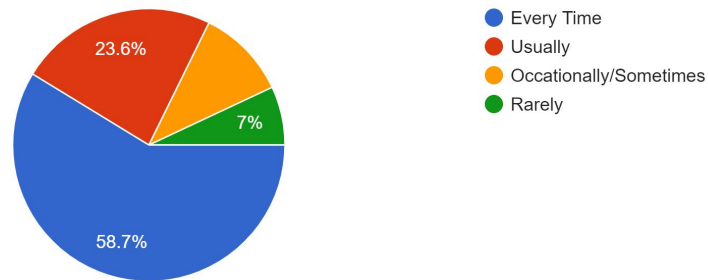
5) Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers?

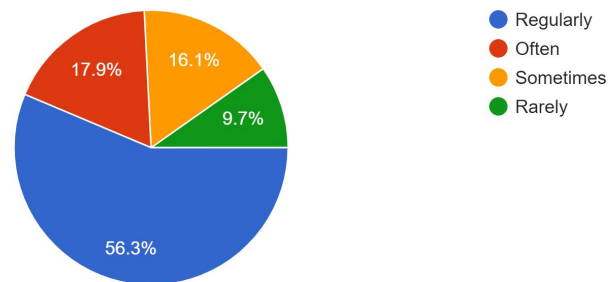

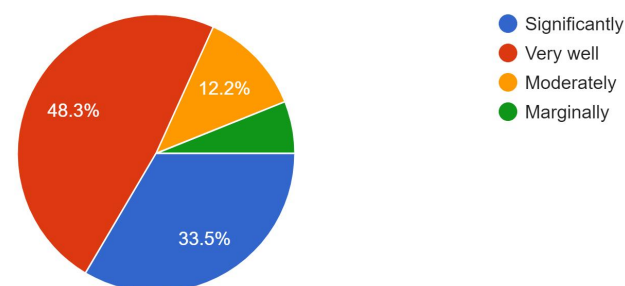

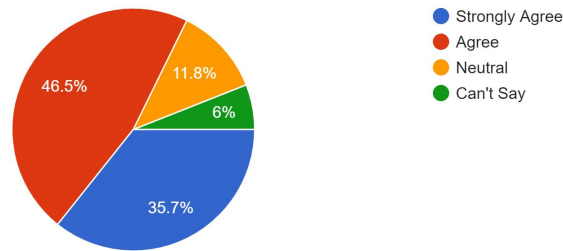

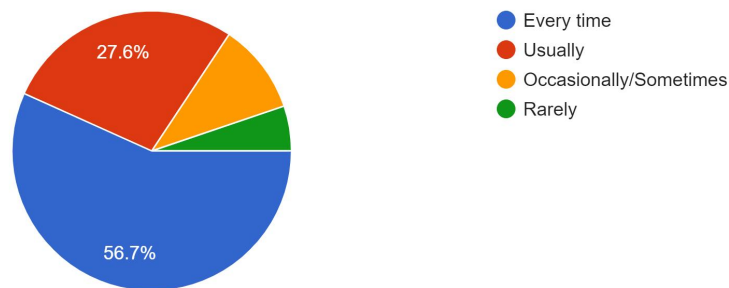

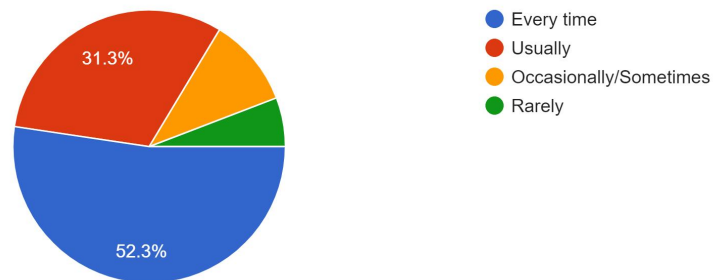

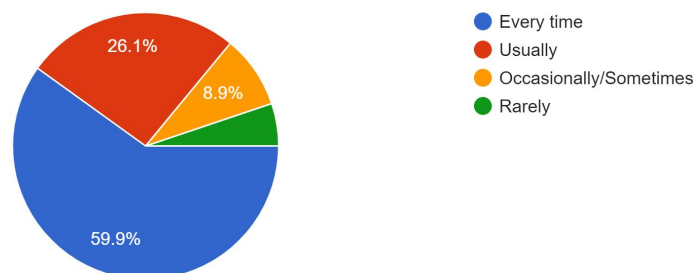

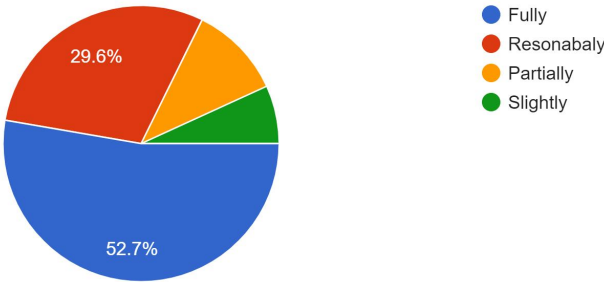


12) The teachers illustrate (explain) the concepts through examples and applications

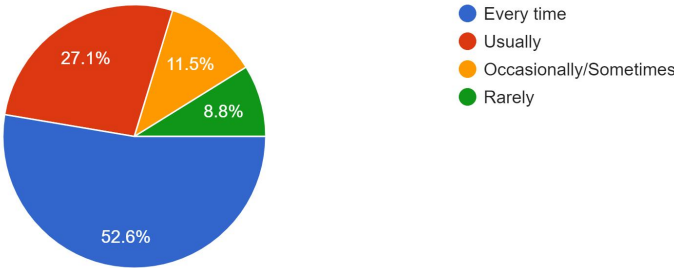

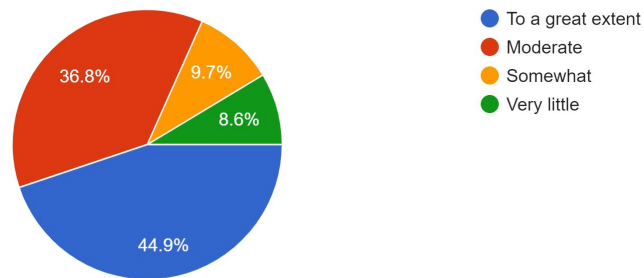

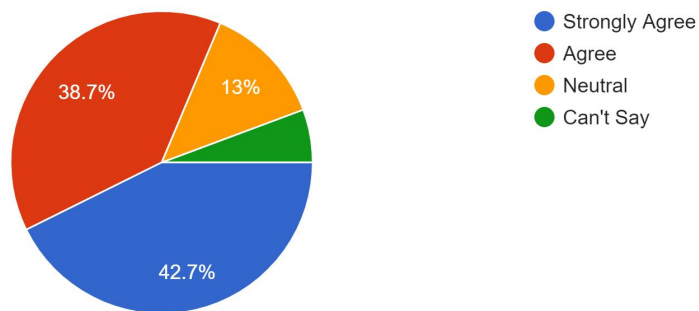

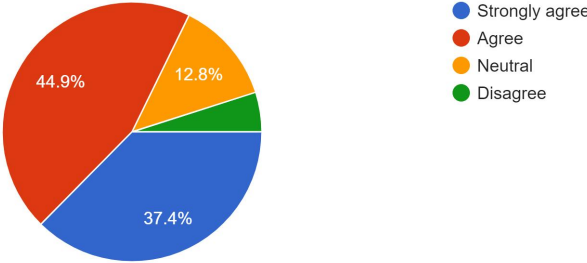
