



Date of the Activity	8 th April' 2023
Organized by	Research & Development cell and Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC))
Objective	The objective of the one-day National level workshop on the New National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 was to provide a platform for educators and stakeholders to gain insights into the key aspects of NEP 2020 and its implications for higher education institutions (HEIs). The workshop aimed to enhance understanding and facilitate discussions on Bloom's Taxonomy, cognitive learning outcomes, digital transformation of HEIs, and the overall overview of NEP for higher education institutions.
Brief Report	<p>The workshop was organized by the Research & Development Cell and Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) on 8th April 2023, at 11:00 am in hybrid mode, accommodating both physical and virtual participants. The event was successfully conducted with three sessions, each focusing on different aspects of NEP 2020.</p> <p>Session I: Dr. Padmakar Shahare from MIT, Pune, delivered a talk on "BLOOM Taxonomy and Cognitive learning outcome." He provided insights into Bloom's Taxonomy and its relevance in shaping cognitive learning outcomes in the context of NEP 2020.</p> <p>Session II: Dr. Jitender Nayak, HoD at Adamas University, Kolkata, spoke on "NEP and Digital Transformation of HEIs." He highlighted the importance of digital transformation in higher education and its alignment with NEP 2020 objectives.</p> <p>Session III: Dr. Mukul Burghate from PDIMTR, Nagpur, presented on "New Education Policy for Higher Educational Institutions: An Overview." He provided a comprehensive overview of NEP 2020, focusing on its key features and implications for HEIs.</p> <p>The program was chaired by Dr. B.V. Khapekar, Officiating Principal, DNC. Shri Hemant Kalmegh was invited as the chief guest, and Dr. M.D. Dhore was the Guest of Honour. In total, 79 participants from across India registered for the workshop. Additionally, all faculty members of Science College, Nagpur, and Dhanwate National College, Nagpur, participated offline in the workshop.</p>


