Trade, economics, culture and tradition of different countries are nearing each other. In such an atmosphere helping hand to each other will have to be proved the best possible access for establishing peace in the world. I heartily pray to save this world from destructive tendencies and shower the world with understanding, co-operation to create the kingdom of peace, by propagating religion, truth and love.
