

A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is hereby established between the Department of Sport Dentistry (SD), Government Dental College & Hospital, Nagpur (GDCH Nagpur), and Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Sports Academy, Department of Physical Education & Sports, Dhanwate National College, Nagpur, hereafter collectively referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party".

The Department of Sport Dentistry operates under the Department of Pediatric and Preventive Dentistry at Government Dental College & Hospital, Nagpur, located within the Government Medical Campus, Hanuman Nagar, 440003, established in 1968. The Fellowship program in Sport Dentistry affiliated with Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik (MUHSN) has an intake capacity of 5 students, accepting both graduate (BDS) and postgraduate (MDS) candidates. This specialized field within dentistry focuses on addressing concerns such as mouthguard provision, dental trauma prevention, and managing oral risk factors affecting athletes' performance, ensuring optimal oral health and performance on the field.

Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Sports Academy, Department of Physical Education and Sports, Dhanwate National College, Nagpur, with its rich tradition since its inception in 1935, has excelled in various sports disciplines. The academy provides modern sports facilities including an indoor stadium constructed in 2016, catering to sports such as badminton, table tennis, gymnasium, chess, cricket, and football. With approximately 500 players receiving training daily, the academy has been instrumental in nurturing sports talent and organizing the Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Sports Festival since 2000.

Desiring to strengthen and develop future cooperation between the Parties in the field of sports and oral health on the basis of reciprocity and mutual benefits for the Parties.

Being Convinced that effective cooperation is in the interests of the Parties and believing that such cooperation would serve their common interests and contribute to the enhancement of sports, oral health, and social development of athletes and people.

AIM OF MOU

The primary aim of this memorandum of understanding is the exchange of sports and oral health knowledge, information, and facilities to promote sports talent and to prevent and manage oral risk factors affecting athletes' health. Additionally, it aims to address the relationship between oral health and systemic health in sports, facilitate research collaboration, and exchange available resources through collaborative efforts to enhance the quality of sports performance.

OBJECTIVES

These objectives will be achieved through various activities conducted on both campuses. Both institutions agree to:

- 1. Mutually exchange expertise in sports-related activities and oral health pertaining to sports.**
- 2. Utilize training facilities for screening, identifying, and educating sports teachers, athletes, and their parents about oral health risk factors specific to athletics.**
- 3. Provide timely support for the management of sports-related traumatic dental injuries among athletes.**
- 4. Execute faculty and student exchange programs for mutual benefit and sharing of knowledge.**

5. Make available infrastructural facilities for training and education related to sports and oral health for athletes.
6. Both the parties agreed that there will be no financial implication related to the activities under this MOU for both the parties till the existence of this MOU.

DURATION

This agreement shall come into effect upon signing and shall be valid for five years unless terminated, revoked, or modified by mutual written agreement between the parties. It may also be extended by mutual written agreement.

SIGNATORIES

This MoU shall serve as the parent document for any program agreements executed between the Parties. Each institution will retain copies of this agreement.




