The scope of the MoU, the roles and responsibilities of the parties of the MoU are given below:

Alliance Objective

As special to a one time implementation, this is a strategic initiative and requires the total commitment of PASSEL and Dhanwate National College (DNC), Nagpur. The University Program initiative would allow Dhanwate National College (DNC), Nagpur, one of the foremost institutions in India in the field of Education, and imparts training, among others in Computer Applications and Information technology faculties, to design world-class curriculum capable of delivering high caliber IT skills required in the fast changing IT marketplace.



NOW THIS MoU WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

DEFINITIONS AS USED IN THIS MoU:

“*MoU*” means this instrument executed by PASSEL and Dhanwate National College (DNC), Nagpur, and subsequent amendments issued to the MoU by mutual consent as provided herein.

“*Program*” means the University Program that is the subject of this MoU.

“*Software*” or “*Product*” means the PASSEL computer software packages identified for introduction in the Program.

“*Curriculum*” means the PASSEL Course that is integrated with the Dhanwate National College (DNC), Nagpur’s Main Course, elective or Projects.

1 BENEFITS TO THE Dhanwate National College (DNC), Nagpur

- 1.1. Opportunity to emerge as one of the competent entities in the academic circles in research and development in the area of Information Technology;
- 1.2. Opportunity to be recognized by the industry and academic circles as one of the preferred locations for acquiring training and skills development in latest technology and software
- 1.3. Opportunity to utilize the Program to train students on PASSEL Software products and technologies.
- 1.4. Opportunity for the faculty and students of Dhanwate National College (DNC), Nagpur to design world class curriculum capable of delivering the caliber of IT skills required at present and also for the future

1.2 Benefits to PASSEL (Aptech Nagpur)

- 1.2.1 Creation of a resource pool of PASSEL Software professionals to boost the existing skill level in the country.
- 1.2.2 Inclusion of PASSEL Software and technologies in the course curriculum of Dhanwate National College (DNC), Nagpur.

2. RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

Each institution will promote internship or/and semester exchange of qualified post graduate students in the other’s academic programs.

a. Faculty: Each institution will promote the exchange of faculty for teaching and/or for collaborative research programs in the area of Information Technology.

b. Exchange: Each student involved in an exchange program will be subject to the admission requirements, tuition and fees of the host institution. Under no circumstances is PASSEL liable for Dhanwate National College (DNC), Nagpur's loss of, or damage, to records or data, as also claims for special, incidental, or indirect damages or for any economic consequential damages (including loss of profit or savings) even if PASSEL is informed of its possibility.



Roles of Responsibilities of centre for Animal Rescue and Study


- a) CARS shall be responsible to take environmental initiatives to create environmental awareness among students, faculties.
- b) To organise field visit to forest, tribal areas to enrich environmental as well as socio-cultural consciousness.


Amendment

The agreement is operated through The Director of The INSTITUTION and Director of The ASSOCIATE. This proposal can be started at **Dhanwate National College Nagpur** initially, which shall be emulated at other colleges.

SCOPE

WHEREAS The ASSOCIATE is engaged in providing training, skill development, and consultation and has strength in development and delivery, innovations and technology trainings etc. particularly in the areas of IT and CS and has approached The INSTITUTION to establish and effective relationship in the larger interest of the sector

WHEREAS the INSTITUTION is a premier professional college, devoted to the advancement of Science and Technology in Information Technology, Computer Science and other related disciplines, has agreed for this mutual association.

Objectives

- Design, develop and deliver programmes ensuring required quality in ICT domain which in turn will lead to professional courses as per the industry requirements and making aspirants employable.
- To be quality skill enhancement partner and projects integrator for corporate and government agencies.
- Faculty Development Programmes (FDP) for institutions and skill training partners
- Working closely with industry for establishing the curriculum as per its requirements and also with academic in order to enhance the quality of Technical and Engineering education in the country.
- Enhancing skills of students/aspirants through internship and industrial training.

Role of the INSTITUTION

- (iv) The INSTITUTION shall treat ASSOCIATE as a training partner for joint activities for mutual benefits.
- (v) The INSTITUTION shall provide accommodation and travelling expenses for free training and workshop if INSTITUTION is out of Nagpur, Maharashtra.

Role of the ASSOCIATE

- (i) The ASSOCIATE shall utilize its strength to align with various skill development programmes and initiatives to meet the objectives of The INSTITUTION. It shall accordingly design and deliver various programmes within the overall scope of MOU.
- (ii) The quality delivery is the responsibility of The ASSOCIATE and The ASSOCIATE would have to have in-house or engage the required manpower and the faculty as per the requirement, in conjunction with the INSTITUTION.
- (iii) The ASSOCIATE shall design, develop and provide practical training to the students.
- (iv) The ASSOCIATE shall market the programmes to make them successful. It shall also guide and support the students for proper placement.
- (v) The ASSOCIATE shall provide free 1-2 days workshop as per company norms.

Joint Responsibilities

1. Marketing & mobilization of the students shall be carried out jointly as per mutual agreed terms.
2. Promotion for the programmes undertaken shall be advertised/ propagated through respective websites of the parties.
3. Technical workshops/ promotional workshops within the scope of the MOU.
4. Assessment of the courses shall be carried out jointly by both the parties.

Financial Agreement(if paid training)

1. Course fee shall be decided in mutual agreement by both the training partners for all the programs to be conducted jointly by The Institution with M/s. APS Microtech Pvt. Ltd.
2. Fee from the students shall be collected by INSTITUTION.
3. Before training 50% payment shall be advance by INSTITUTION, then ASSOCIATE can start training.
4. Direct Marketing Cost (say advertisements in newspaper, arranging an event at the INSTITUTION) shall be shared,after confirmation by both parties in the ratio of 50:50.
5. The INSTITUTION shall not be liable for discharging any financial commitments made by the ASSOCIATE and vice-versa.

Duration and Termination of Agreement

MOU shall be effective from the date of signing and shall remain in force for a period of oneyear. It shall automatically be renewed for next one year until & unless discontinued by either party.

The INSTITUTION has the right to terminate the agreement for non-performance of the ASSOCIATE, based on half yearly detailed reviews.

In case the ASSOCIATE intend to terminate the contract, it shall communicate the INSTITUTION six months in advance and in addition it shall meet all its obligations for the running or announced batches. In case of even long duration batch (if any), it is obligation of the ASSOCIATE to make it successful.

Confidentiality

The INSTITUTION agrees and confirms that all Intellectual Training Material shall at all time vest in and remain with and belong to the ASSOCIATE and cannot be used for at least two years from the date of termination / completion. The INSTITUTION shall not be liable for any suit on account of demands for infringement of copyright etc. by the ASSOCIATE which has no nexus with the objective of the MOU.

General Provisions

- (i) Both the Parties have full power and authority to enter into this MOU and take any action execute any documents required by the terms hereof; and that this MOU,entered into has been duly and validly executed and delivered, and is a legal, valid, and binding obligation of, enforceable in accordance with the terms hereof; and that the executants of this MOU are duly empowered and authorized to execute this MOU and to perform all its obligations in accordance with the terms herein.

- (ii) This agreement shall not be binding for any other agreement for either party. Parties shall be free and independent to carry on other services and trainings besides that covered under the scope of this agreement.
- (iii) The ASSOCIATE & The INSTITUTION shall perform their duties in strict compliance with all applicable laws in India along with rules and regulations of duly constituted Govt. authorities in India and shall obtain all licenses, restrictions or other approval, if any, required by laws in India in connection with the services to be rendered hereunder.
- (iv) The ASSOCIATE shall strictly follow the INSTITUTION norms, rules and regulations for conducting the programs and shall maintain the INSTITUTION high standards.
- (v) Both parties can use logo, trade name, course modules & other related materials for promotion of the courses to be conducted jointly within the scope of this MOU.
- (vi) Both parties shall promote the arrangement and courses through respective websites

Notices

Unless otherwise provided herein, all notices or other communications under or in connection with this MOU shall be given in writing and may be sent by personal delivery or post or courier or facsimile. Any such notice or other communication will be deemed to be effective if sent by personal delivery, when delivered, if sent by post, two days after being deposited in the post and if sent by courier, one day after being deposited with the courier, & if sent by facsimile when sent (on receipt of a confirmation to the correct facsimile number).

Arbitration

- In the event of a dispute between the ASSOCIATE and The INSTITUTION arising out of, or relating to this Agreement, its interpretation or performance hereunder, the parties shall exert their best efforts to resolve the dispute amicably through negotiations.
- In case of any disagreement and dispute and the parties fail to mutually resolve the issue; both parties shall appoint an Arbitrator that is mutually agreeable and shall be settled as per Indian Arbitration Act, arbitrator charges shall be paid by individual party.
- Further, in case the parties failed to resolve the dispute; this Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the law within the state of Maharashtra, India. Jurisdiction shall be Court of Nagpur Maharashtra.

WHEREAS:

- A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:

- B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.

- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interest.

CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the First Party's **Institution** and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 **Curriculum Design:** Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 2.3 **Internships and Placement of Students:** Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the Internship and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs, as per the proposal shared separately by the second party. The Second Party will also register itself on AICTE Internship Policy Portal for disseminating the Internship opportunities available with them.
- 2.4 **Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of **Digital Marketing specialization, activities and services - -**.
- 2.5 **Skill Development Programs:** Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- 2.6 **Guest Lectures:** Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.
- 2.7 **Faculty Development Programs:** Second Party to train the Faculties of

First Party for imparting industrial exposure/ training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.

- 2.8 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein
- 2.9 There is no financial commitment on the part of **Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Institute of Management Technology & Research, Congress Nagar, Nagpur**, the First Party to take up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY



CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY



Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.


