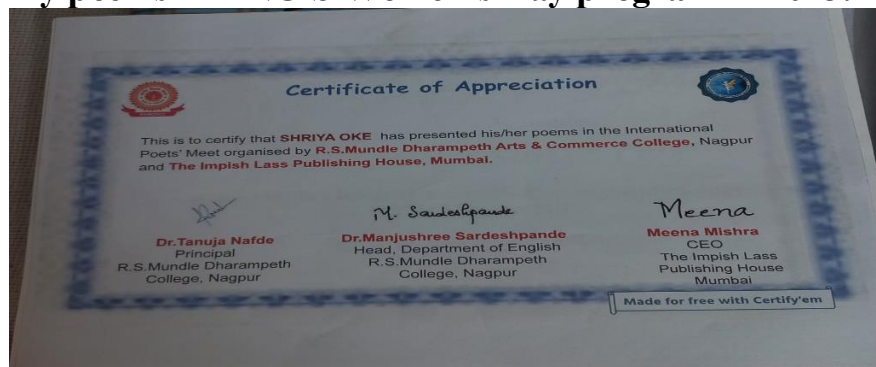


2. Won the second prize in the online essay writing competition organized by the literary club of Gondia Education Society on the topic: SAVITRIBAI

Lost Humanity

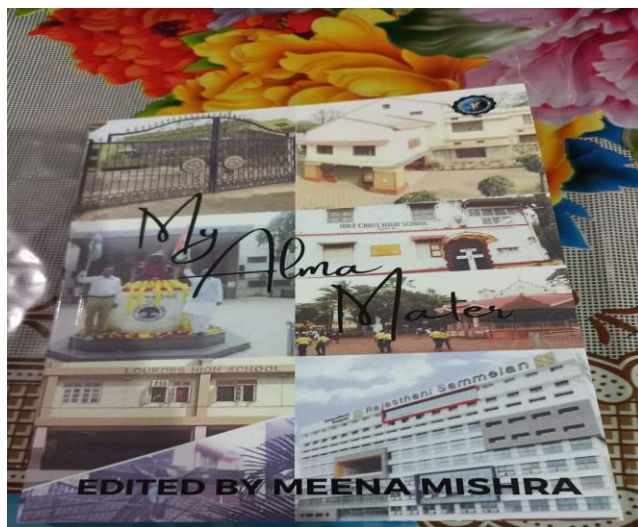
In Kerala, near the silent valley zone,

Resounding morning chorale.

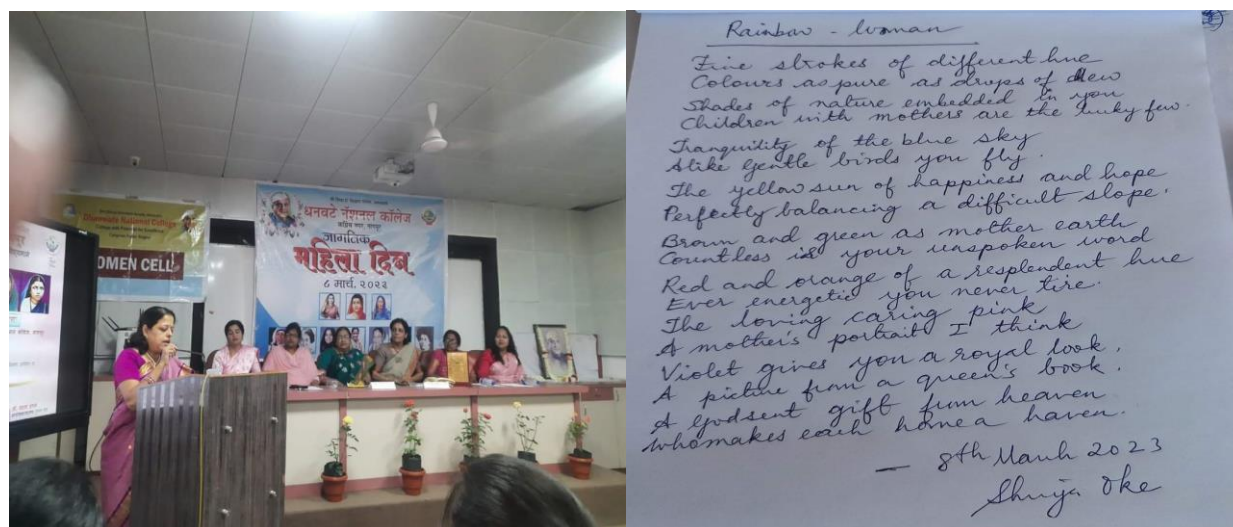
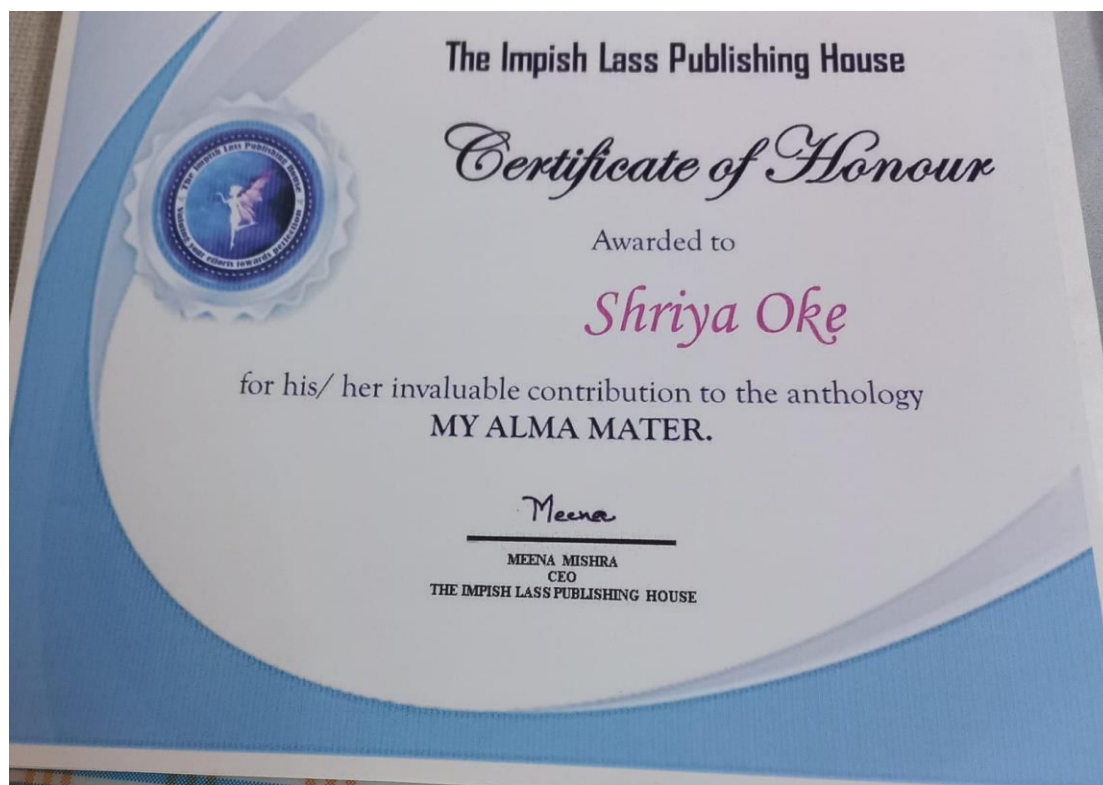
Music, dance, sports and play,
